*working group Tatort Stadion*

The working group scene Stadium is an association of pro-active football fans of the four Viennese clubs SK Rapid Wien, FK Austria Wien, Vienna, and First Vienna FC 1894 Sport (c) club and the fan-coordination pro supporters Austria. The aim of the working group is to campaign for respect and tolerance and promote a colorful, creative, safe and non-violent fan culture. We will also fight racist and fascist tendencies in the Austrian fan culture and showing, that another part of fan culture is possible.

*content*

The exhibition "Tatort Stadion II" is now the second edition of a traveling exhibition on the topics of football and discrimination. The first "Tatort Stadion" - exhibition was shown in more than 200 cities in Germany, in Austria, however, only in Innsbruck. In the center of the new edition is again the documentation of racist, homophobic, sexist and anti-Semitic incidents in and around German football stadiums. We are the opinion, that the themes showed by the exhibition has in Austria a less social attention and get mostly ignored by the local media. So we don't want only show german facts. We want also to document discriminatory incidents in the local fan scene, but also showing counter-strategies of pro-active fan groups and helping football fans, who has problems with discrimination. The exhibition will I also deal extensively with active prevention work and various ways and means for fans and fan projects, demonstrating its focus and discussing it. We will give Pro-active initiatives against racism and other discrimination fans a platform to present their work. So we can promote a positive fan culture and show the usage of respect and tolerance. To create more awareness for the topic but also to meet the political educational mission, there will be a number of side events (see preliminary program schedule) in the form of workshops, guest lectures by international consultants/speakers, panel discussions, press conferences and anti-racist network meetings. We will also produce a free fanzine which is dealing with the items of the exhibition.

*Time frame*

The exhibition starts on 26 of september and ends on 12 of October

*location/venue*

The exhibition and the majority of the events take place in the venue Mo.ë, Thelemangasse 4/1, 1170 Vienna.

*consensus*

The organizers are for a positive fan culture, tolerance, respect and fair play. We will not give access to the exhibition to Nazis or potential interferers as well as to the events. This is also cited in the house right by the organizers. In case of violation, the persons present are removed, according to the house rules. In addition, the exhibition is free. There is no entrance.

*Social preventive approach*

The series of events promotes a positive fan culture, tolerance, respect and fair play. With the exhibition and series of events we want to achieve the youth/ young football fans of the Viennese clubs

and to raise the issues of racism, sexism, fascism, homophobia and violence. Conflict resolution should be identified and treated in realistic models. International and national consultants/speakers, including social workers and scientists, will give an important input. It will be discussed about possible solutions. Practical strategies are developed to promote pro-active fan work in Austria's terraces.
